

# ACCESS TO PRO-BONO IMMIGRATION ATTORNEYS

## SAN DIEGO COUNTY SPECIFIC RESOURCES:

- **San Diego Rapid Response Network Line (SDRRN)**
  - Phone Number: (619) 536-0823
    - Call this number to report immigrant detentions and to request immigration legal assistance. Due to high call volumes, the Network may not be able answer your call right away but leave a message with your name and phone number and you will be called back as soon as possible.
  - Operating Hours: Monday–Thursday from 8:30am–5:00pm and Fridays from 8:30am–4:00pm.
- **Mexican Consulate in San Diego**
  - Offers FREE immigration legal screenings for Mexican Nationals at their office (1549 India St, San Diego, CA 92101) every Tuesday. They are also going to help Mexican Nationals prepare a Plan B (Including dual citizenship for US citizen child, etc.)

- **San Diego County Immigrants' Rights Legal Defense Program (IRLDP)**
  - Phone Number: (619) 446-2883
    - For individuals detained at Otay Mesa Detention Center in San Diego they can dial: 1157#. **This number is free to dial, and the individual will not be charged for this call.**
  - When to call: If a loved one is detained and in deportation proceedings or a loved one is in alternative to detention status and has ties to San Diego County. This program seeks to connect individuals in deportation proceedings to a free attorney.
  - What information to have ready: For individuals calling the IRLDP number, be prepared to provide name, date of birth, detention A#, expected immigrant defense issue (i.e. asylum, criminal conviction removal, suspension of deportation, etc), and other information regarding your case.

## IMPERIAL SPECIFIC RESOURCES:

- **Mexican Consulate in Calexico**
  - For Mexican nationals in CBP detention, the Consulate will visit them twice a day every day at Aten Rd.
  - The Mexican Consulate goes inside the Imperial Regional Detention Facility twice a week to provide legal assistance to Mexican nationals currently detained in ICE custody.

- **Immigrant Defenders Rapid Response Legal Resource Hotline (SoCal)**

- Phone Number: 213-833-8283
  - Operates Monday-Friday 9am-4pm
- It applies to all Southern California and is intended to be used if your loved one or a community member is detained by immigration.
- What to expect:
  - You will receive information about legal resources
  - This call is not for legal advice and does not guarantee legal representation.

- **ACLU of San Diego & Imperial Counties Legal Intake Line**

- This intake line is intended for non-emergency requests for legal assistance. Please note that we typically need 1-2 weeks to respond and sometimes it may take longer.
- Submit a request via a voicemail message.
  - For San Diego County, call 619-232-2121, and press “4”, giving your name, email and a brief description of the issue you wish to discuss.
  - For Imperial County, call 760-638-8932, giving your name, email and a brief description of the issue you wish to discuss.
  - Your call will be returned by an ACLU-SDIC staff member.
